TOURNAMENT RULES

1. C.C. Cobra Kai bowling tournament is a non-sanctioned handicap invitational tournament open to all bowlers, with the exception of current PBA Bowlers which will not be allowed to bowl this tournament. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification. All entry fees & winnings will be forfeit.
2. Teams will be comprised of 4 member teams which will include at least one member of the opposite sex. Team maximum average shall be 820. Each bowler will bowl three games on Saturday and three games on Sunday. Their six game totals will be used to determine the top four male & female bowlers which will compete in a stair step roll-off. First place roll-off winners will bowl a one game title match against last year's champion. Winners will receive the Belt and a free entry to next year's tournament.
3. Bowlers will use one of the following averages:
 - a. Current ITA average of 36 games or more or 72 game ITA average if current is less than 36 games. As of April 1st 2016.
 - b. Highest 2014-2015 USBC Book Average or current highest USBC average if no book avg available.
 - c. If none of the above is available bowler must enter the tournament with a scratch average of 220.
 - d. Handicap will be based on 80% of 220 for men & women with no cap.
4. Any player not present at the time the shift begins shall be considered late and will receive a 0 (zero) for each frame missed.
5. A substitute will be permitted on Sunday provided his/her average can be verified by the tournament director. Team must stay within max team average of 820. No absentee score will be used.

6. Any protest affecting eligibility, scoring, or general playing rules must be specified, and must be submitted in writing to the tournament director before Prize Fund Payoff. All tournament director decisions are final.

7. No Refunds shall be given after the entry has been received.

8. Open bowling will not be permitted on tournament lanes 60 minutes prior to squad starting time.

9. In addition to the above rules, USBC tournament rules will govern the operation of this tournament.
