TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Tournament is a non sanctioned handicap mixed tournament. Tournament director has the right to refuse any bowlers or entry. Tournament director has the right to adjust any bowlers average.
- 2. No touring pro bowlers will be allowed to bowl. Violation of this rule will disqualify the individual and the team members as well. No Money will be refunded.
- 3. Team maximum average is **1025** Team must consist of 3 men and 2 women, 4 men and 1 woman or viceversa.
- 4. Total scratch and handicap series will determine where a team places. 3 games Saturday and 3 games Sunday.
- 5. Bowlers will use one of the following averages in this order:
 - 1. Current ITA average based on 36 games as of May1, 2023
 - 2. 72 game ITA average
 - 3. Highest 2021-22 USBC winter book average. (Minimum of 21 games)
 - 4. Current league average of a minimum of 36 games as of May 13, 2023
 - 5. Sport averages will be adjusted according to USBC adjustment
 - 6. No summer averages will be used.
 - 7. All others will bowl scratch.
- Tournament handicap is 80% of 210. There will be <u>no</u> maximum handicap for bowlers using an ITA average.
 The maximum individual handicap for bowlers <u>without</u> an ITA average will be <u>40</u> for men and <u>60</u> for women.
 Team Cap: 1025. Team Handicap: 80% of 1025
- 7. Team captains are responsible for team check in. Any corrections or changes to team roster, averages, or handicap must be reported before the start of the first game. Any bowler arriving after the start of the tournament competition will receive zero for all frames missed. A substitute may bowl on Sunday but must bowl all 3 games and cannot put team over 1025 cap.
- 8. If a bowler abuses any of the bowling center equipment, the bowler will be immediately disqualified from the tourney and forfeits any claims for prize fund, side pots, brackets, etc.
- 9. Any protest affecting the eligibility, scores bowled, or general playing rules, must be specified in itself, and must be filed in writing with the tournament director prior to pay off.
- 10. ALL TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS DECISIONS ARE FINAL
- 11. No refunds will be made after entry has been received.
- 12. Tournament bowlers will not be allowed on the tournament lanes after they have been oiled.
- 13. In addition to the above rules, USBC tournament rules will govern the operations of the tournament.
- 14. Capital City Bowlers and Mel's Lone Star Lanes will not be responsible for accidents occurring before, during, and / or after any event of the tournament.
- 15 Remittance must accompany each entry. Club checks, cashier checks or money orders only. <u>CASH</u> only on the day of the tournament.
